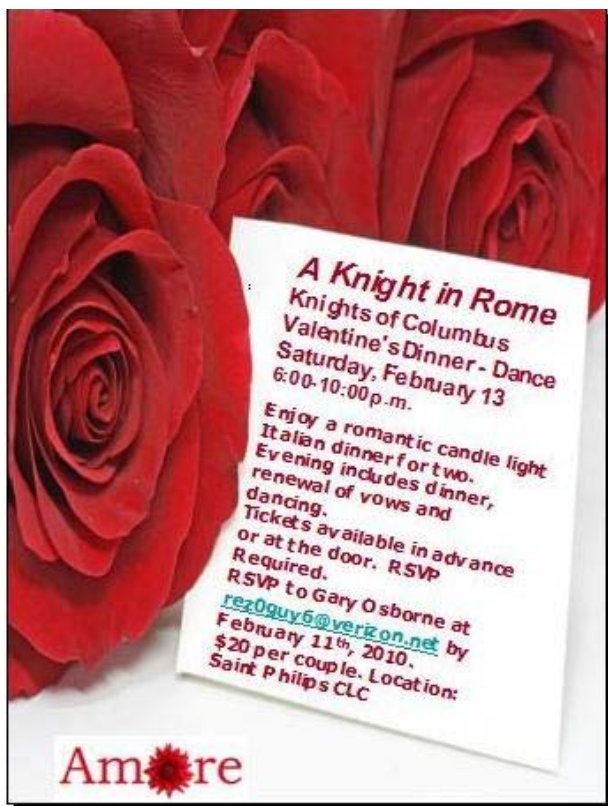
## Grand Knight's Report
