EASTER

Easter is a special day of celebration because it represents the fulfillment of our faith as Christians. St. Paul wrote that, unless Christ rose from the dead, our faith is in vain. Through his death, Christ saved mankind from bondage to sin, and He destroyed the hold that death has on all of us; but it is His Resurrection that gives us the promise of new life, both in this world and the next.



At the Easter Vigil Mass the church will bring in many new members who went through the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA). Get to know these “new” Catholics and make them welcome in your parish.

NEW ROMAN MISSAL

It seems a long way to the beginning of Advent, but we all need to start looking at the changes that will affect us when we go to Mass.

Most of us know that the response to “The Lord be with you” will become “And with your spirit”. There are also changes to the Gloria (and just think of the people who have to create the new music to fit the words), the Nicene Creed and the Apostles Creed to mention a few.

When I was looking at the changes the one word that made me wonder was “consubstantial”. Here is the section it appears in the Nicene Creed “God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, **consubstantial** with the Father”. I did not ever remember this from my youth and wondered where it came from. A little research showed it was part of the creed adopted by the church in 325 AD. It’s always been there but the translations in the 1960s were a little liberal with the English language.
