Special Call Meeting August 18th.

There will be a special call meeting Aug 18th for the purpose of updating new Bi-laws. At the July meeting the Bi-Laws committee submitted and they were accepted by the body present. Now it is up to membership to vote. According to present Bi-Laws dated in 1959 a majority vote from a quorum of at least 20 members is required to pass. Items up for vote: *Annual Dues:* \$20; *Monthly Meeting Day:* 3rd Thursday month; *Quorums: Quorum for a meeting* 10; *Quorum to Amend Bi-Laws* 20; *Maximum Amount to be Paid per Transaction at a Regular Business Meeting:* \$500; *Relief Fund:* none; *Corporate Communion:* None; *Memorial Committee: Memorial Mass for the Deceased:* No Masses, *Chalice program:* Not participating. Instead of Masses or donating Chalices, Assembly 1097 has been donating \$100 to the Bishops Seminarian Fund. Under the present structure this cannot be added to the Bi-Laws. Assembly 1097 has been doing this on our own without it being in the Bi-Laws for many years.

Please attend this meeting for discussion and questions on these items before voting on them.

Deposits: I believe at this time all checks have been deposited. Let Steve or Tony know if yours has not cleared yet.

Dues Notice's: Our Faithful Comptroller Art Valdez has been transferred to Houston by the VA and is no longer in town. I have appointed Alvin Springgate to the Comptroller position until a willing replacement comes forward. Not having many records to go by, Alvin has sent out dues notices to all those we show in arrears. If you have paid let Alvin know, give him the check number, time you paid, and if you received your card. If you paid cash let him know that as well. In the future if you pay in cash paperclip your name and member number to it; we can then keep better tabs on it until deposited. We currently have 50 paid out of 220+. Will have better info next meeting.
