SUPREME CHAPLAIN'S MONTHLY

When Simon Peter saw this, he fell at the knees of Jesus and said, "Depart from me, Lord, for I am a sinful man." For astonishment at the catch of fish they had made seized him and all those with him, and likewise James and John, the sons of Zebedee, who were partners of Simon. Jesus said to Simon, "Do not be afraid; from now on you will be catching men." (Gospel for Feb. 6, Lk 5:8-10)

Simon Peter recognizes Jesus for who he is and deems himself unworthy to be in his presence. Jesus, in calling the fisherman to follow him, tells him not to fear. Every one of us is a sinner, and yet Jesus calls each of us to follow him. It is not our own virtues or qualifications, but rather Jesus who empowers us with his grace to respond to his invitation. Brothers, remember St. Paul's words: "I have the strength for everything through him who empowers me" (Phil 4:13).

Challenge by Supreme Chaplain Archbishop William E. Lori:

This month, I challenge you to go to confession and attend at least one weekday Mass, offering it for the intention to fearlessly answer Christ's call to follow him. Second, I challenge you to participate in or consider starting the Faith in Action into the Breach program.

Questions for Reflection:

Are you sometimes afraid to follow Christ more closely because you consider yourself too sinful and unworthy? Do you truly believe in and experience Christ's mercy and seek to forgive yourself as well as others? Do you stay close to the sacrament of penance in order to do battle with your own sinfulness and allow God's grace to strengthen you for spiritual combat?

Have You Heard of COMDEX Ranking?

To answer this question, allow me to quote from the June 25, 2019 article of Janet Hunt entitled "What is the Comdex

Ranking of Your Insurance Company?"

"A Comdex ranking is a composite score averaging the ratings of the major [insurance rating organizations](#) including [A.M. Best](#), [Fitch](#), [Moody's](#) and [S&P](#). The Comdex is not, in reality, a rating but rather a ranking based on the average of all the different ratings these different organizations give an insurance company. "The Comdex rating is on a number scale of 1 to 100 with a higher number being the better ranking. If an insurance company's Comdex ranking is 80, this means it scores higher than 80% of all other insurance companies with multiple ratings. An insurance company must have ratings from at least two insurance rating organizations to have a Comdex ranking."

Why is COMDEX Ranking important? It is important because it is a measure of an insurance company's financial strength. Would you like to buy insurance from a company with a low COMDEX Ranking? I have seen at least two insurance companies whose names are familiar to many of us with COMDEX Rankings of 62 and 32 respectively. When an agent from an insurance company solicits our business, wouldn't it be a good idea to ask what the COMDEX Ranking of the company he represents is? Can a company's ranking change? Of course, it can change depending on its performance.

I am sure your next question would be: "What is the ranking of the Knights of Columbus?" It's 98. As one who has policies with the Knights of Columbus, I feel confident that, when I die, my family will receive the benefits.
