- KC HALL ICE MACHINE HISTORY research shows our 2001 vintage machine was giving us trouble in 2009 as we were considering a new machine. Different repairmen were trying various ideas and finally had some success, and the machine did pretty well until early 2012. We again began considering a new machine when it was suggested that the bottom part (ice bin cabinet) was in good shape but the top part with the controls, coils and compressor were in bad shape. A supplier offered to search for a top part that would fit our existing bottom part. In April 2012 a new top part was purchased for \$1700. The old 2001 model had a 300 lb/24hr. capacity. The new top unit was rated at 500 lb/24hr. The machine had been doing pretty well but now is having costly repair problems again. Officers are shopping for a new machine.
