Star Council Awards

As we head into the second half of the year, I want to remind all that the Star council Award is a lot more than a name on a plaque. The award is meant to encourage successful behaviors in all councils. Make sure and keep up with your council's progress in the Star Tracker.

Coming up in the next few months:

in the month these are paid, the easier it is for our state office staff to get these processed.

January 31 – This is the due date for the Survey of Fraternal Activity Form 1728. The information provided on this form is what Supreme uses to prove to the IRS we are a charity, so it is vital this be completed on time. Many councils are late with this form because they are trying to be very accurate in their accounting. The good news is no one audits this report. Remember that accuracy is nice, but timeliness is mandatory.

Also on this date, submittal of a Form 10784 for Special Olympics (SO) activities is required for the LSA with Distinction. Every council that pays State Charities contributes to Special Olympics, so count 2.5% of that payment as a SO donation on the Form 10784.

February 15 – The next Semiannual Audit Form 1295-2 is due. This assures the financial health of your council, so please get this done.

March 1 – This is the deadline for several things. First are entries to the state contests – State Service Program Awards, Family of the Year, Chaplain of the Year and State Education Grants. Submittal of at least ONE of these forms is required for the LSA with Distinction. These contests are scored within a week of receival, so be on time submitting to Pat Henz. If State Per Caps were not previously paid, this is the deadline for payment for the LSA.

Also, you should have had at least one more program in each of the FIA program areas to put on your SP-7. And you hopefully will have completed your Fraternal Benefit Night requirements. The Columbian Award Form SP-7 can start being submitted after this date.

Please mail payment to: Knights of Columbus Council Accounts, PO Box 382172, Pittsburg, PA 15251-8172. **Do not mail the payment to Supreme.** If you have already paid, thank you. If you are on the list & have paid, please send copy of check & date sent & we can help remove your council off the suspension list. Supreme Per Capita is due before April 10.

Note State Per Capita was assessed based on July 1 Roster. This is due before March 1.

District Deputies & Grand Knights, we still need to make our Roundtable goal. Please fill in this form. Note the Grand Knight <u>MUST</u> sign the form! We can crush this goal! Email all forms to Dan Aguiliar - <u>aguilar.daniel65@gmail.com</u>. He will verify we have no duplicates, before it is sent to Supreme.

Texas State Council Charities:

"Give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over, will be poured into your lap. For with the measure you use, it will be measured to you." Luke 6:38

- As of December 29, 2023, Fundraising Chairman David Keating reports State
 Council Charities contributions to State Council Charities have
 totaled \$733,617.51 with FOURTEEN Dioceses over 67%! This equates
 to 91.57% of our annual goal well done Texas! We have a couple of
 reporting days left to make Quick Start Council, Quick Start District Deputy,
 and Honor Roll Diocesan Deputy. PLUS, earning Quick Start is a requirement
 to earn the Lone Star Award for Excellence with Distinction at the end of the
 year.
- **Beaumont** is the first Diocese to contribute over 100% of their annual goal. Tyler has now done it along with El Paso and Victoria.
- **546 (up 27) Active Councils** have already met or exceeded 100% of their State Charity Goal in the last 8 days.
- 648 (up 36) Councils have paid State per Capita
- 532 (up 38) Quick Start Councils (qualify by December 31)
- **104 District Deputies** have already qualified for Quick Start.
- A final Quick Start report will be published the end of next week. We will count checks in the mail!

This encompasses most of the expenses. We appreciate your commitment to State Charities and supporting your local Bishops!
