March Reminders –

- Consider a Spiritual Reflection or Into the Breach during Lent for men of the parish.
- o Good Friday Family Program March 29
- o Easter Egg Hunt with religious items hidden in some eggs.
- Submit the Family of the Month (for Feb) by March 15
- Submit any Fraternal Program Report (#10784) for each activity you had last month.

• April Reminders -

- This is the last Quarter of the Fraternal Year what programs do you still lack for Star Council? Plan them now.
- o Check and see if your local pregnancy center needs an Ultrasound machine
- Special Olympics Spring Games be a volunteer.
- Get ready for the 118th State Convention. Lots of great workshops on Friday and Saturday.
- Submit the Family of the Month (for March) by April 15
- Submit any Fraternal Program Report (#10784) for each activity you had last month.

• May Reminders -

- The Seminarians will be leaving school for the summer so don't forget them.
 Send them a note and some money to help them through the summer.
- Are any of your Seminarians getting ordained? Have the council show him that you support him and will be praying for him.

- Have you conducted at least four programs in each of the Life, Family,
 Community, Faith categories? You have two months to get them done.
- Submit the Family of the Month (for April) by May 15
- Submit any Fraternal Program Report (#10784) for each activity you had last month.
- Submit your Columbian Award SP-7 now. If there are any issues, you have time to get it corrected.

Remember: Every Program is an opportunity for every Knight to put their Faith in Action and step Into the Breach.

Star Council Awards

In March, we should be focusing on completing all the tasks required to reach Star Council status. Make sure and keep up with your council's progress in the Star Tracker.

As of now, your council should have:

- Recruited at least 75% of your membership goal
- Hosted at least two Fraternal Benefit Events with at least 10 or 14 unique members or membership eligible men (for councils less than or greater than 100 members)
- Submitted the Service Program Personnel Form 365
- Submitted the Survey of Fraternal Activity Form 1728
- Be 100% Safe Environment Compliant
- Be up to date on Supreme Per Capita payments

If your council is lacking in any of these areas, NOW is the time to get caught up. Upcoming in the next few months:

Columbian Award Form SP-7

March 1 marks the date this form is typically accepted at Supreme. I recommend submitting this form at the earliest opportunity since that will allow time to react if there are issues.

To fill out the form, download the PDF version, fill it out, and submit it by cut and pasting into the Online Portal. You cannot save your work in the Online Portal and submit later. And you can only submit online once – if you submit an incomplete form, you're now going to be emailing in a PDF and waiting weeks, if not months, for it to be processed.

These guidelines must be met when submitting this form:

- Programs must be organized by the council or involve significant participation by council members to qualify. Program descriptions should reference how they meet these criteria.
- Programs must engage members by enhancing faith and spirituality, serving a charitable purpose, or a combination of the two. Program descriptions should reference how they meet these criteria.
- Councils must earn at least four (4) program credits in each of the Faith in Action categories: Faith, Family, Community, and Life. Refer to the <u>Faith In Action Handbook</u> or visit <u>www.kofc.org/faithinaction</u> for more information on programs.
- Two program credits can be earned for programs meeting <u>Featured Program</u>
 <u>Minimum Requirements</u>. The supporting paperwork (Form 10784 or Reimbursement forms) must have been filed in support of the Featured Program. All non-featured programs and programs not meeting minimum requirements earn 1 program credit.

 Do not check the Featured Program button if you are not counting it as two.
- Donations alone do not qualify unless they result from the council's fundraising
 activities or are for a Faith in Action program activity (i.e., Ultrasound Initiative, Global
 Wheelchair Mission, etc.). If a donation is made for a non-Faith in Action program or
 no fundraising activities were carried out by the council, the council must also report
 non-monetary support to qualify.
- Participating or volunteering for standard liturgical functions generally does not qualify for program credit. Examples of non-qualifying activities include attending or serving at Mass or funerals, ushering, or participating as a "Eucharistic Minister", lector, choir member, etc.
- Programs taking place during Cor, such as Holy Hour, the Rosary Program, Men of the Word Bible Study, Into the Breach, etc., qualify for credit. However, Cor itself does not qualify for program credit.
- Refer to the <u>Sample Columbian Award Application</u> for an example of an acceptable form.

Our Order & State Family needs you continue to do your part to ensure we continue to grow.

Remember Supreme Per Capita billing is based on January 1, 2024 roster. We still have councils on the suspension list this past October 10. Please see remind those councils to par their Per Capita! They must go online for the Supreme Per Capita Statement:

Contact us if you need help finding your statement. Please mail payment to:
Knights of Columbus Council Accounts, PO Box 382172, Pittsburg, PA 15251-8172. **Do not mail the payment to Supreme.** If you have already paid, thank you. If you are on the list & have paid, please send copy of check & date sent & we can help remove your council off the suspension list. Supreme Per Capita is due before April 10.

Note State Per Capita was assessed based on July 1 Roster. This is due before March 1.

Several Dioceses are in different stages of establishing a new Council or reactivating a council. Continue the work to bring new or active Councils to all eligible Catholic men. All the forms you need can be found at the following link:
