Texas State Charities received over \$5,000 in donations for the Maui Fires we have sent to Supreme to add to the \$200K they have already sent to Hawaii.

I mentioned last month that **SK Pat Conway** was selected to be the Vice Supreme Master for the Our Lady of Guadalupe Province, and the Sir Knight selected to replace him as Master of the Sword for the remainder of this Fraternal Year is **SK Joe Rodriguez** from the Archdiocese of San Antonio, who previously held this position in 2018-2020.

For Fraternal Year 2022-2023, Co-Diocesan Deputies of the Year were **Craig**Modrzynski of Fort Worth Diocese and Larry Pfeifer of Tyler diocese. The District Deputy of the Year was DD 92 Robert Schmidt of Galveston-Houston.

Last month, around 50 Proud Texans from the Lone Star State descended on Orlando, Florida for the 141st Supreme Convention. We proudly left our mark being recognized for attaining the **CIRCLE OF HONOR** last Fraternal Year. Texas also had the #1 Grand Knight in membership gain by **Dennis Eveland** of Council 17991 in Laredo with 1040% of membership quota attained.

Our Insurance program had two General Agents in the Top Ten of the Order. **Thomas** Supak was 157 Percent of Quota and Tony Rangel with 151 Percent of Quota. **Jody Supak** of the Supak Agency was recognized as Top Field Agent with 649.32 Percent of Quota. **Thomas Supak** has decided to retire as General Agent, and he is closing the Supak Agency. Star Council Awards

Your Fraternal Year is hopefully off to a great start. By this time, your Report of Officers Chosen Form 185, Service Program Personnel Form 365 and Semiannual Audit Form 1295 should have been submitted to Supreme. If any of these are still outstanding, please get them done ASAP. And this means you District Deputies – you need to be in possession of all these completed forms for your councils.

By this time, your Grand Knight, Program, Family and Community Directors should be Safe Environment compliant. E-mails were sent to those men when the forms above were submitted. Use the link in those e-mails to take the training. If the e-mail has been lost or not received, contact the Supreme Office of Youth Protection at oxport/ when the forms above were submitted. Use the link in those e-mails to take the training. If the e-mail has been lost or not received, contact the Supreme Office of Youth Protection at oxport.org/ to get a new link e-mailed.

And we are still waiting for our first Safe Environment report. It is beyond my control to make it happen any faster.

In the coming months, your council should be focusing on the projects you want to include on your Columbian Award Form SP-7 come next May. Try to have two programs every month in each of the four Faith In Action program areas to assure your council will qualify for Star Council.

You also should have your first Fraternal Benefit Event planned or already held. Work with your Field Agent to develop programs that fit the needs of the membership of your council and parish.

And don't forget that your Supreme and State Per Caps are due now. On October 10, your council will be suspended if Supreme Per Caps not paid. So that's not the DUE date – that's the drop-dead date. Pay now!

DISTRICT DEPUTIES – your Form 944 for each of your councils is due no later than September 15. That does not mean do it on September 15 – the system will likely go down that day as thousands of DDs try to submit their reports. Do it NOW since it takes 1-2 minutes to complete. Here is the link:

Note the same link is used for all reactivations. Chairman Greg Dutchover is ready to work with you through the reactivation process. Let us work for you. I hear the Laredo Diocese is also working on several reactivations. Will it get done by September 30? I would like to give that Diocesan Deputy a "Knight on the Town". All Diocesan Deputies are eligible & there is time to get it done.

Worthy District Deputies, please remind your councils to go to Officers Online to download their Supreme Per Capita Statement. I have been told some councils still do not understand they are not getting a paper statement from Supreme. Go to: www.kofc.org sign in>Click on Reports tab>Click on Financial Statement.

Supreme's 1st half and any past due Supreme Per capita will be on this statement. This is due before October 10, 2023. Note TSC Per Capita (\$10/member) has already been sent out through the mail. This statement will also include your TSC Charity Goal.

State Per Capita is due by March 1st or earlier for certain State Awards. Note for ALL Diocesan Deputy or District Deputy Incentives – your home Council MUST be current with Supreme & State Per Capita.

Our team is ready to help you get to your goal; all you need to do is ask.

Texas State Council Charities:

Charity is the first and foremost principle of the Order. Our Bishops need us to meet and exceed our State Charity goals! 70% of the funds you send to the State Office go directly back to the Bishop in each Diocese for their charity of choice. Once the Diocese exceeds 100% of goal then 100% of the additional funds go back to the bishop! Seven weeks into the new Fraternal Year are behind us now. As Knights, your councils have contributed nearly 40% of our annual goal in less than two months! That, coupled with paying State per Capita, has qualified over 220 councils to earn the coveted Charity Quick Start Award! What impresses me mostly about this is that statements were received by councils at the end of July. Remarkable! Detailed results will be sent once August is behind us so all councils can

evaluate their performance for the first two months of the year. I ask ALL councils to take care of their State per Capita and State Charity obligations by the end of December at the latest. Can we do this? THANK YOU for what you are doing!

The American Wheelchair Foundation is the First Lady's charity of choice! Each wheelchair you purchase for \$150 positively affects up to 10 other family members. July was a slow month to start the year however you still raised ~\$40,000. This year we have a chance to exceed \$1MM in wheelchair donations. To get there, we need NEW councils and Parishes to participate for the first time. A common misconception is that a Wheelchair Sunday will take away from needed Parish contributions. We have not seen this. Plan your Wheelchair Sunday Drives with our help. If not able to do so, each council is asked to contribute \$150 for one wheelchair at a minimum. Do you have your Knights of Columbus License Plate yet? For a mere \$30 extra per year you can proudly display your Texas 'K of C' License Plate which contains the words "One Nation Under God". \$22 of these funds come back to the state to help Retired Priests in each Diocese!
