Faithful Scribe's Script

SK Faithful Scribe Joe O'Connor: May 13 is the Feast Day of Our Lady of Fatima, who gave three secrets to [Sister] Lucia, the oldest of the three children who saw Our Lady and the only one to reach adulthood. At the instruction of her Bishop in 1944, she wrote out the third secret, which was not released until 2000. There is some evidence that what was released was not the complete text; instead, the third message of Our Lady of Akita is said to provide the missing part. The Three Secrets of Fatima

- First Secret: Vision of Hell with demons and souls of the damned
- ➤ Second Secret: The consecration of Russia to Immaculate Heart of Mary (IHM) and the restorative Communion of the First Saturdays will lead to the conversion of Russia and peace [This did not happen until 2022—previously, the IHM consecration was made for the world rather than for Russia due to diplomatic reasons]
- ➤ Third Secret: Apocalyptic warning of a divided Church and the wiping out of a large part of humanity if there is not repentance to combat the works of the Devil [from Our Lady of Akita's third message]

Our Lady of Fatima requested that the Third Secret of Fatima be revealed by the Pope in 1960. It was not. In a 1980 interview with a German newspaper, Saint John Paul II stated the Third Secret had not yet been disclosed due to the "seriousness of its contents" and "not to encourage the world wide power of Communism to carry out certain coups." Not until 2000 did Saint John Paul reveal Third Secret. Meanwhile in 1973, the same year abortion became commonplace throughout the world. Our Lady appeared to a deaf nun in Akita, Japan, with an apocalyptic warning of a divided Church and the destruction of a large part of humanity. [See the upcoming October 2023 issue for more about Our Lady of Akita.] The Bishop of Akita was convinced that Our Lady of Akita's warnings were any extension of the Third Secret of Fatima. In a 1998 interview, Howard Dee, the Philippine Ambassador to the Holy See. stated that Cardinal Ratzinger (later Pope Benedict XVI) had "personally confirmed to me that these two messages, of Fatima and Akita, are essentially the same." Our Lady of Akita's third message said to pray the Rosary, echoed by Saint John Paul II in his 1980 interview when "He held up his rosary and stated 'Here is the remedy against this evil. Pray, pray and ask for nothing else. Put everything in the hands of the Mother of God'."
