Jerry was a Medical Administrator for several practices in Kentucky, Georgia, and retired from Pulmonary Specialists of Tyler. One of his fondest jobs was working at Granite City Steel, that produced the material that built the St. Louis Arch.

He is survived by his loving family including his wife of 38 years, Susan Moore Belobraydic; his daughter, Emily Anne Belobraydic; his two sons, Michael Emil Belobraydic, Paul David Belobraydic and his wife, Ali; his sister, Linda Belobraydic Schneider and her two daughters, Laura Starosta and Lisa Nelson; his brother, Donald Joseph Belobraydic and his son, Matthew Emil Belobraydic. Our assembly had the poorest turnout with only three officers in attendance. Things happen, and prior commitments are made, but the expectation is that unless excused by the District Master, officers are to attend the installation.

Raffle Fundraiser

Once again it has been decided to have a raffle to raise money for the assembly. SKs Philip Marsh has graciously taken the chair to organize the raffle. Last year the raffle raised over \$2,000 for the assembly and we hope to have the same success again this year.

Members of the assembly are asked to take three books of 10 tickets and either sell or buy them. The tickets are \$5 each or 3 for \$10, therefore the three books have a max value of \$150 if sold individually or \$100 if sold in groups of three.

First prize for this year's raffle will be a complete box of \$2 Texas State Lottery Scratch-Off Tickets with a guaranteed minimum pay-out of over \$100 and the possibility to win up to \$30,000. Second and third prizes are Visa gift cards of \$100 and \$50 respectively.

We will again offer the same incentive as last year. Ten tickets from the District Master's annual raffle have been purchased by the assembly and have been designated for the top seller. Last year, SK Philip Marsh sold the most tickets and then with his ten incentive tickets he won \$350 for 2nd prize.

This is the only fundraiser our assembly does each year so we need every member to pitch in to make it as successful as possible. We will only be selling 1,000 tickets so people have a very good chance to win. Tickets will be handed out at our next meeting so please make every effort to attend.
