**From the March Officers and Council Meetings:** GK Kenny Svrcek reviewed the calendar for upcoming events and KC Hall bookings for April: This will be a busy month with Mayfest planning meetings every Tuesday at 6:30pm. In addition to the usual meetings, bingo and food truck visits, the RVFD Giveaway and Place of Hope Fund Raiser. (see the calendar)
