- **SUPER BINGO** for January started the year off nicely with 162 players.....the most in quite awhile. Both jackpots full amount of \$600 were paid out. Lately, jackpots were reduced based on crowds being below 150 players. Three of the "Event Games" were played as well. Lets hope the crowds keep coming.
- **FOOD PANTRY VOLUNTEERS** for January were Milton Frei, Phil Konarik, Pete Ramirez, Manual Doud, Frank Garcia, Ronnie Mancillas, Jim Grametbauer and Tom Hormuth. - **COUNCIL ALLOCATED FUNDS** in December for utility bills: AT&T Phone bill - \$146.44, Dish TV \$109.24, Ambit Energy Electric bill - \$1096.35, Waste Conn dumpster - \$187.29, SWMWSC water bill - \$114.40, Misc, Maint. \$349.82, 2018 4th Quarter Sales Tax \$920.66, Hall Insurance Annual bill \$5,649 paid \$2,559.60 towards total, 2018 State Charity Assessment \$1340 (Bingo Fund \$567.20 + Council \$772.80 = \$1340).
- **HALL FLOOR CLEANING MACHINE** has been giving the cleanup crew lots of trouble and is falling apart. The machine has been checked out by a vendor for an estimate of repairs. Considering the age of the machine and the amount for repairs the council voted to invest in a new machine at a cost of \$5603.83.
- **NATIVITY TAKE DOWN AT ST. JOSEPH'S** was held Monday, Jan. 7th at 4:30pm to repack and store the figurines and shelter for next year. The site was cleaned up as well. Helping with this task were GK Kenny Svrcek, Manual Doud, Pat Watson, Charlie Watson and Phil Konarik.
