- **\$544,560** is what the KC Hall, land and contents are valued at for Milam County and Rockdale ISD property taxes. However, our tax bill is \$0 instead of \$11,381. We are exempt per the discretion of taxing authorities as we are a charitable organization performing benefit to the community. We are a Red Cross Shelter, support community events and benefits including the food bank trucks, flu clinics, senior citizens expo, job fairs, meals-on-wheels, RCS Food Pantry, Christmas Roundup to name a few. Our facility, with a reasonable rent (including volunteer staff), allow other organizations to hold fundraisers and events. This is why we fill out those little forms to track our volunteer hours.
